This park-like, majestic, natural setting provides a very beautiful and comforting final resting place for members of The Jewish Center and their families.

Burial plots are offered to congregants in good standing who have been members for three years or more immediately prior to purchase or who have completed their Capital Improvement Fund commitment. Plots are available at \$1500 each; in addition, an \$1800 maintenance charge and \$1500 tax deductible contribution to The Evan M. Frankel Endowment Fund of The Jewish Center of the Hamptons are required for each individual plot.

DIRECTIONS

from The Jewish Center of the Hamptons,
 44 Woods Lane, East Hampton
 to Shaarey Pardes Accabonac Grove Cemetery,
 306 Old Stone Highway

Woods Lane / Route 27 East
 bear right at East Hampton windmill

Turn left onto Accabonac Highway
 (just past Post Office on your right)

Accabonac bears right & continues under Railroad trestle.

Continue to end of Accabonac;
 go through intersection bearing right onto Old Stone Highway

Look for small wooden sign "306" on your right,
 About .6 miles;
 turn slowly into driveway and pull up to wood gate.
 If locked, park and walk in through opening on left.
 If unlocked, please drive slowly and
 only on inner loop surrounding pond.
